PG ADMISSION NOTIFICATION FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-2023

Applications are invited for admission to the following Post-Graduate subjects for the academic session 2022-2023.

The candidates will fill up the Application Form through **online portal** (http://rnlkwc.ac.in) after successful completion of all the steps (e.g., filling in the personal details, academic details, uploading photo, relevant mark sheets and signature) with the cost of Rs 200/-.for admission test.

The students of Vidyasagar University & autonomous colleges affiliated to Vidyasagar University/Other universities are eligible to fill in forms for admission to Post-Graduate and with their Percentage (%) of Marks (Part-I, II & III) obtained in UG (Honours) in annual system . In case of semester system, applicant have to fill SGPA obtained in SEMESTER-I and SEMESTER-VI through online system as per the rule fixed by the home institution. All the candidates have to produce all the original marksheets, certificates and identity proof at the time of physical verification.

As per notification no 507-Edn(CS)/10M-95/14 dated 30th June, 2022 of Govt. of West Bengal , **80%** of total seats in each subject will be reserved for the students of Vidyasagar University& autonomous college(s) affiliated to Vidyasagar University and the rest **20%** seats are open to all (including students of Vidyasagar University& autonomous college(s) affiliated to Vidyasagar University)

Question pattern: Short answer type carrying 2 marks each.

Test duration: 1 hour 30 minutes

Full marks: 50

Number of questions to be answered: 25

Time: 12.00 noon and 2.00 pm (Microbiology and Nutrition)

Application Fees: Rs. 200/- (Two hundred only)

(E) SELECTION AND ADMISSION PROCESS

(i) The PG courses offered by the Institution are self-financed.

(ii) The PG admission process will be based on **Entrance Test**.

(iii) Merit point will be calculated out of 100 marks (50 marks from entrance Test and 50

marks is obtained from average of SGPA of SEMESTER-I and SEMESTER-VI (if

examination conducted through offline mode) or from SGPA of SEMESTER-I only(not

from SEMESTER-VI as examination conducted through online mode) in case of CBCS

system or 50 marks is obtained from UG (Hons) examination (Part-I, Part-III & Part-III

taking together in case of annual system)

(iv) Merit list will be published in the college website and selection process is done through

merit and entrance scores.

(v) In case of a tie, marks obtained in the immediately preceding Examinations are to be

considered for ranking.

(vi) As per order of the Govt. of West Bengal, 80% of total seats in each subject will be

reserved for the students of Vidyasagar University& autonomous college(s) affiliated to

Vidyasagar University and the rest 20% seats are open to all (including students of

Vidyasagar University& autonomous college(s) affiliated to Vidyasagar University)

(vii) Reservation policy will be considered as per Govt. order 906 Edn / Estt dated

18.09.1997. The category wise percentage (%) of reserved seat is as follows: SC-22%, ST-

6%, OBC-A-10%, OBC-B-7%. Fraction of 0.5% or more will be rounded to the next whole

number.

(viii) 5% of each category(Gen/SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B) will be reserved for differently-

abled candidates. Merit list will be prepared on the percentage of disability. In case of non-

availability of differently-abled candidate, the seat reserved for differently-abled candidates

of the particular category will be converted to that Category only.

(ix) 1% of total seats of all PG courses are reserved as Sports/ Culture quota.

How to calculate Merit Point Calculation?

Illustration: SGPA in SEMESTER-I=7.48

SGPA in SEMESTER-VI=9.00

Merit Point= Marks obtained in entrance test out of $50+(7.48+9.00)/2\times5$ in case of SEMESTER-VI conducted through offline

Merit Point= Marks obtained in entrance test out of $50+7.48\times5$ in case of SEMESTER-VI conducted through online (SGPA in SEMESTER-VI is not considered as the examination is conducted through online mode)

Merit Point= Marks obtained in entrance test out of 50+50% of percentage of marks obtained in UG (Hons)marks obtained in annual pattern

[If a candidate obtained 65% marks in UG (Hons) the merit point = Marks obtained in entrance test out of 50+32.5]

- (ii) Age proof document (Birth certificate/Admit card of Madhyamikor10thclass examination showing date of birth/etc.) [100KB-150KB,JPG]

- (iv) VU and other university applicants will upload two (2) Mark sheets of Sem.-I and Sem.-VI for CBCS and three (3) Mark sheets of Part-I to Part-III for annual system.
- (G) The following documents have to be brought by the provisionally admitted candidates at the time of physical verification
- (i) Print out of the online filled in application form to be submitted at the time of verification.
- (ii) Self-attested photo copies of all the Mark sheets of Examinations passed (10th onwards), University Registration Certificate and a Passport Size coloured photograph affixed in the box provided in the Form.
- (iii) Self-attested photo-copy of the Admit Card/ Certificate of H.S. or equivalent /Madhyamik as evidence of the date of birth.
- (iv) Self-attested photo-copy of SC/ ST/ OBC-A/ OBC-B/ differently-abled certificate (/s) issued by the appropriate authority.
- (v) Self-attested photo-copies of the Certificate of Games & Sports/ Cultural Competition (International/National/ State in the last two years), for those applying under respective quota.
- (vi) Migration Certificate (for other university candidates only) must be submitted within two months.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- (i) Application form, if not properly filled in and accompanied with attested copies documents as stated above, is liable to be cancelled.
- (ii) All admissions are provisional and the admitted candidates are required to produce all originals of uploaded certificates, Mark sheets and testimonials for physical verification. Candidate or his/her authorized person is to be present at the time physical verification as and when notified.
- (iii) The physical verification of testimonials & other documents for provisionally admitted students will be held in the concerned departments by the appropriate bodies when students will be asked to report for their offline classes in the Campus
- (iv) If at any stage, it is found that a candidate has concealed, suppressed or distorted any information/fact, in the application form, her admission to the College, if granted, shall stand cancelled.
- (v) Admission will be cancelled if the original documents are not found in conformity with the declaration in the forms submitted online.
- (vi) **Once the candidate admitted in any course may transferred or cancelled his admission in any self-financing course the admission fees will be not refunded or adjusted.
