Applications are invited through **online portal** (http://rnlkwc.ac.in) for admission to the following Post-Graduate subjects for the academic session 2024-2025. The students will fill up the prescribed application form with the personal details, academic details and upload the mark sheets (1st Semester to 5th semester for the students whose 6th semester result is awaited and 1st Semester to 6th semester for passed out students), certificates, photo and signature . The submission of online application fees (non-refundable) is Rs. 400/- for all category of students. The admission will be done on the basis of merit. The reservation policy for deciding seats will be followed as per the order issued by the Govt. of West Bengal.

(D) APPLICAION PROCEDURE

- (i) The applicants will fill up Application Form only through online portal (http://rnlkwc.ac.in) for admission to PG courses for the session 2024-25.
- (ii) The submission of online application fees (non-refundable) is Rs. 400/- for all category of students.
- (iii) The students will fill up the prescribed application form with the personal details and academic details
- (iv) The students whose 6th semester mark sheet is awaited will have to upload the 6th semester mark sheet and SGPA (6th sem) after publication of 6th semester result.

- (iv) Upload the mark sheets (1st Semester to 5th semester for the students whose 6th semester result is awaited and 1st Semester to 6th semester for passed out students)
- (v) Caste/EWS certificate [100KB-150KB,JPG]

(F) SELECTION AND ADMISSION PROCESS

- (i)The selection will be made on the basis of merit.
- (ii) Merit calculation will be notified later on.
- (iii) As per latest order of the Govt. of West Bengal ,80% of total seats in each subject will be reserved for the students of Vidyasagar University& autonomous college(s) affiliated to Vidyasagar University and the rest 20% seats are open to all (including students of Vidyasagar University& autonomous college(s) affiliated to Vidyasagar University)
- (vii) Reservation policy will be considered as per latest Govt. order. The category wise percentage (%) of reserved seat is as follows: SC-22%, ST-6%, OBC-A-10%, OBC-B-7%. Fraction of 0.5% or more will be rounded to the next whole number.
- (viii) **3% of each category(Gen/SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B)** will be reserved for **differently-abled** candidates. Merit list will be prepared on the percentage of disability. In case of non-availability of **differently-abled** candidate, the seat reserved for **differently-abled** candidates of the particular category will be converted to that Category only.
- (ix) 1% of total seats of all PG courses are reserved as Sports/ Culture quota.

- (i) Print out of the online filled in application form to be submitted at the time of verification.
- (ii) Self-attested photo copies of all the Mark sheets of Examinations passed (10th onwards), University Registration Certificate and a Passport Size coloured photograph affixed in the box provided in the Form.
- (iii) Self-attested photo-copy of the Admit Card/ Certificate of H.S. or equivalent /Madhyamik as evidence of the date of birth.
- (iv) Self-attested photo-copy of SC/ ST/ OBC-A/ OBC-B/ differently-abled certificate (/s) issued by the appropriate authority.

- (v) Self-attested photo-copies of the Certificate of Games & Sports/ Cultural Competition (International/National/ State in the last two years), for those applying under respective quota.
- (vi) Migration Certificate (for other university candidates only) must be submitted within two months.
- (vii) Print out of the admission receipt
- (viii) ABC-ID Certificate
- (ix) Self-attested EWS certificate issued by competent authority

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- a. The PG courses offered by the Institution are self-financed
- b. Once the candidate admitted in any course may transferred or cancelled his admission in any self-financing course, the admission fees will be not refunded or adjusted.
- **C.** Application form, if not properly filled in and accompanied with attested copies documents as stated above, is liable to be cancelled.
- **d.** All admissions are provisional and the admitted candidates are required to produce all originals of uploaded certificates, Mark sheets and testimonials for physical verification. Candidate or his/her authorized person is to be present at the time physical verification as and when notified.
- **e.** The physical verification of testimonials & other documents for provisionally admitted students will be held in the concerned departments by the appropriate bodies when students will be asked to report for their offline classes in the Campus
- f. If at any stage, it is found that a candidate has concealed, suppressed or distorted any information/fact, in the application form, her admission to the college, if granted, shall stand cancelled.
