Career Counselling Services:

Both present and passed out students can participate in the career counselling programs where they are guided to select different courses for higher studies. The cell also helps to select them different career option.

CAC in collaboration with RICE Education-Medinipur conducted "RICE talent scholarship test for the students of UG 3rd & 5th semesters and PG students as well as research scholars to avail the scholarship from RICE Education and many students were benefitted by the events.

A Webinar Series on Career Opportunities entitled "Emerging Technologies and their job prospect" were held online in collaboration with IQAC of the college on 19/08/2021. A huge number of the UG 3rd & 5th semester and PG students were benefitted by the event. A total of 632 participants registered for the Webinar and attended the event.

An Entrepreneurship skill Development Programme was jointly organised by CAC and Balaka Alumni Association of the College.

Through

this programme, we are trying to nurtre the talent of youth by enlightening them on various aspects of industries/ business activities. Various stalls would be presented by the students and Alumni of our College to promote Social Entrepreneurship and sustainable Development. By creating new products and providing services, entrepreneurs can generate new employment opportunities.

A 'Workshop' on 'Google news initiative for fact finding' was conducted on 26.09.22 in collaboration with google news initiative and IQAC of the College. Respected Speaker Mr. Pulakesh Ghosh had delivered an inspirational speech on fact checking and fact checking jobs in India.

A Career Guideline Workshop was organised on 11.11.2022 in collaboration with Rice Education and IQAC of the College. Respected Speaker Mr. Partha Saha, AVP-Rice group inspired the students by his motivational speech on career guidance. His speech gave the students sufficient information, knowledge, experience and skills, necessary to identify career options and help them to make a career decision.

Scholarship Help Desk where 1st year students of our college obtain information, forms and assistance for filling up forms and submission of same for various scholarship schemes like W.B. Merit cum Means Scholarships, SC/ST Scholarships, Minority Scholarships, Scholarships for PH students, Jindal Scholarships, Nabanna, Sheela Kanoria Scholarships, Colgate Scholarship, Jio Scholarship, Priyambada Birla Scholarships, G.P. Birla Scholarships etc. A total of 36 candidates of 2020-2021 session were awarded scholarships by CSR, TATA Metallics which was coordinated by Scholarship Help Desk of CAC.

Central Computer Centre with Internet is maintained for our present students on all days including holidays for our hostel boarders.

Library facilities with newspaper, journals and books for competitive examinations are maintained on all days including holidays for our hostel boarders.

Psychological Counselling unit continues to function beyond college hours. Here a trained and experienced psychologist and an experienced psychiatrist are available to cater to the mental health of our students. In

this pandemic situation, CAC has initiated online psychological counselling sessions with Dr. Nibedita Goswami, an eminent clinical psychologist withan experience of more than 18 years.

Certificate Courses:

Certificate courses are designed for our students to develop or strengthen specific career skills. The aim of our certificate courses is to enhancing and enriching the students learning experience. In addition to the conventional UG and PG courses, the college also offers a number of job- oriented certificate and diploma courses to enhance skill and capabilities of students for recruitment in various organizations.
