1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

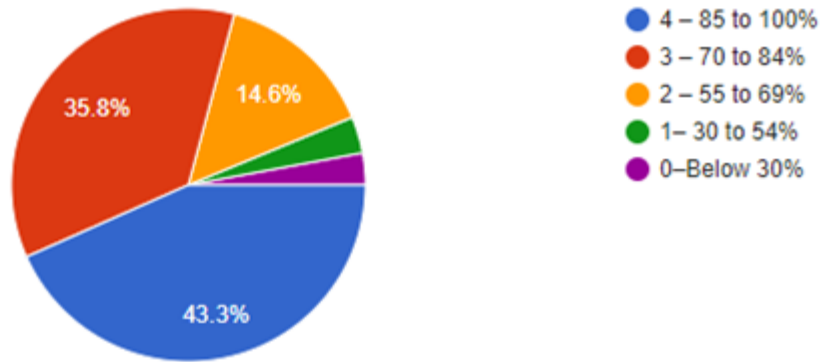


CHART-1 : Pie chart showing the Perception of Students on cover of syllabus in various Department of the College.

2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

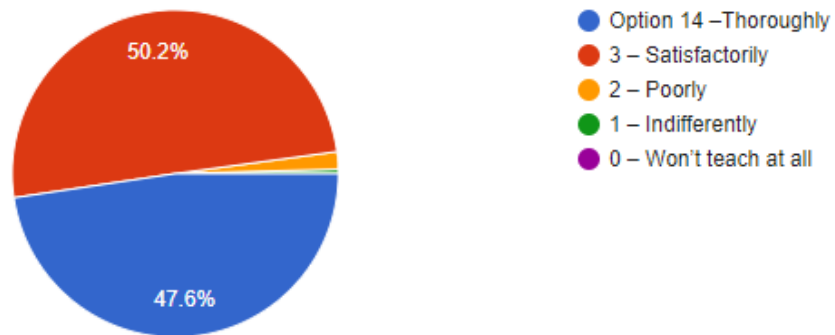


CHART-2 : Pie chart showing the perception of students on preparedness of teachers for the classes.

3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

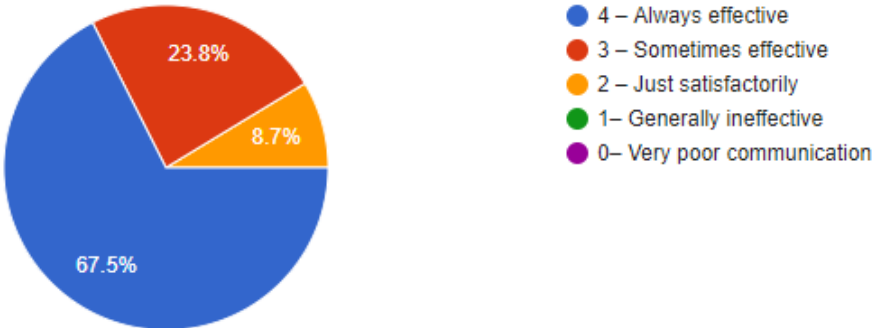


CHART-3 : Pie chart showing the perception of students on communication of teachers

4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

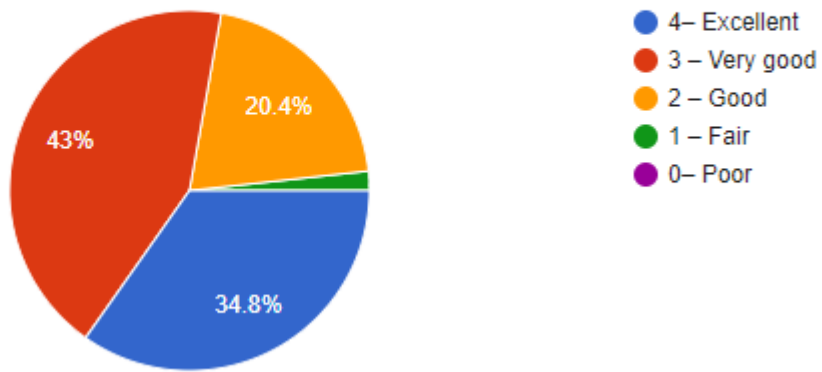


CHART-4 : Pie chart showing the perception of students on Teacher's approach to teaching

5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

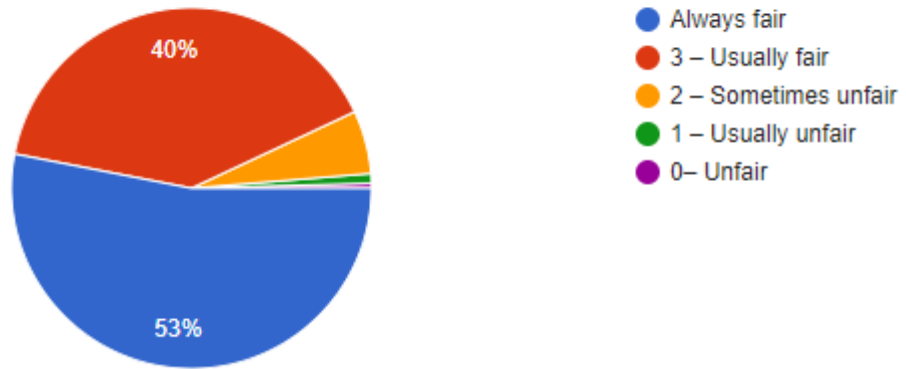


CHART-5 : Pie chart showing the perception of students on fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers

6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

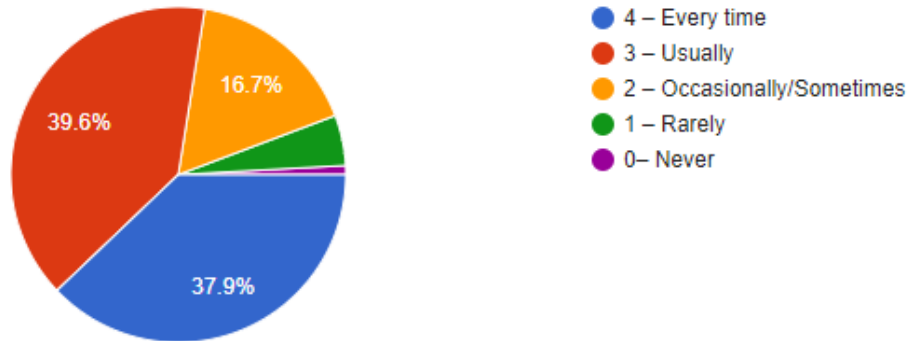


CHART-6 : Pie chart showing the perception of students on discussion on performance in assignment with students

7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.

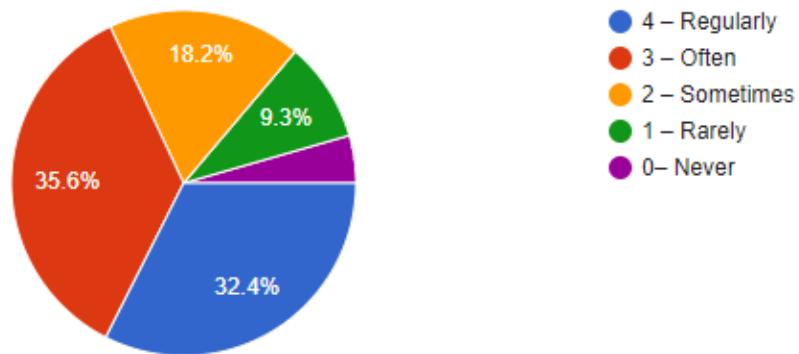


CHART-7 : Pie chart showing the perception of students on active interest of the institute in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students

8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.

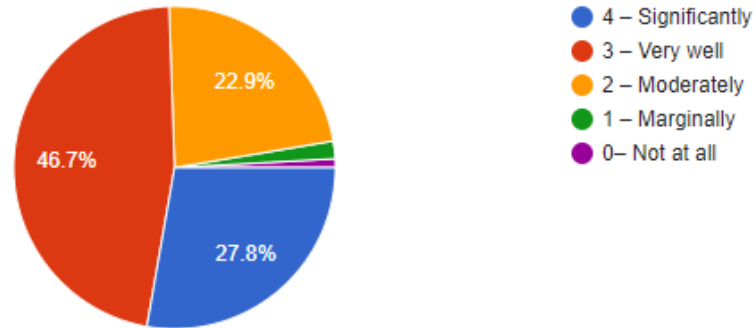


CHART-8 : Pie chart showing the perception of students on teaching and mentoring process of the institution facilitates in cognitive, social and emotional growth

9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

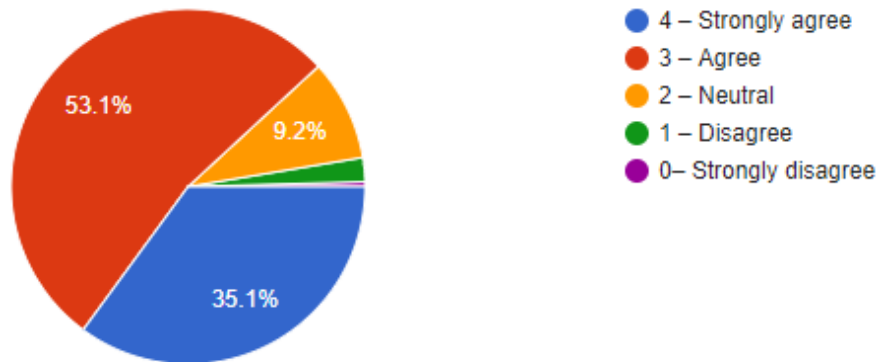


CHART-9 : Pie chart showing the perception of students on multiple opportunities of institution to learn and grow

10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.

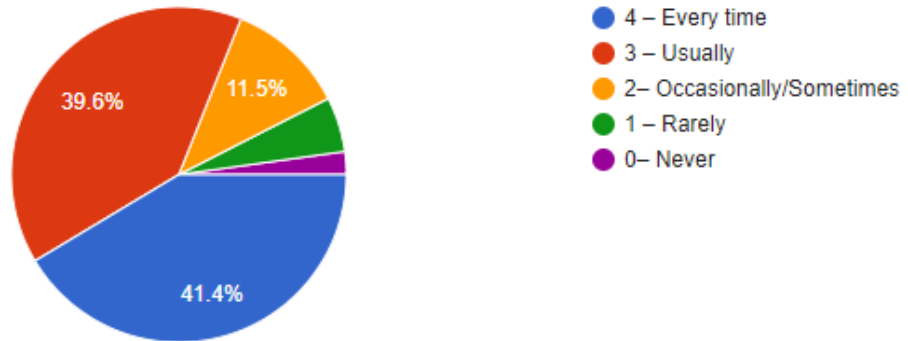


CHART-10 : Pie chart showing the perception of students on teachers inform students about their expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes

11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.

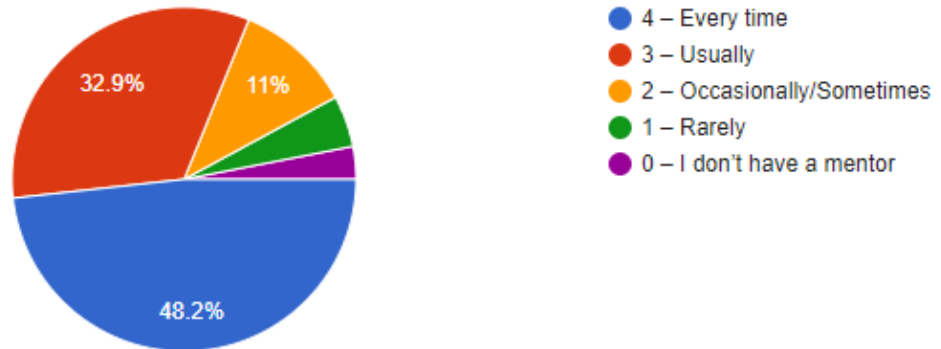


CHART-11 : Pie chart showing the perception of students on mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to students

12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.

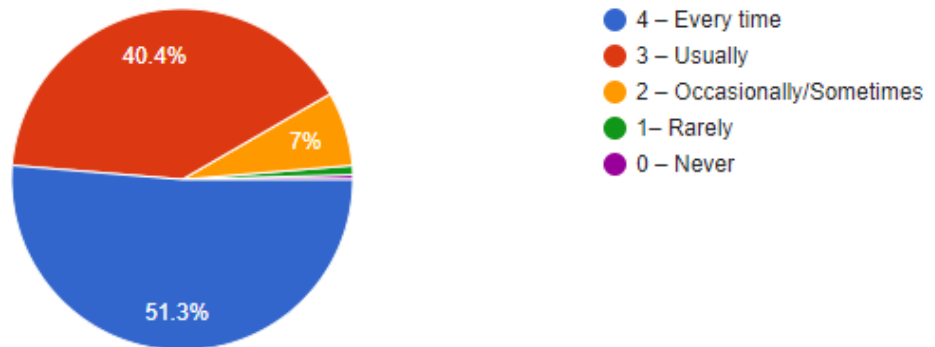


CHART-12 : Pie chart showing the perception of students on the teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications

13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.

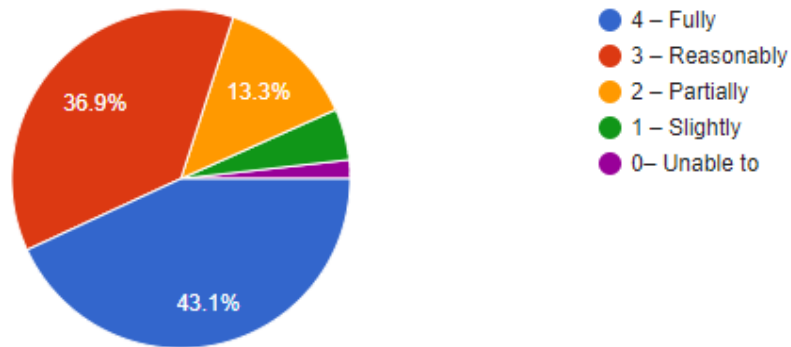


CHART-13 : Pie chart showing the perception of students on identification of students' strength by their teacher and encouraging student with providing right level of challenges.

14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.

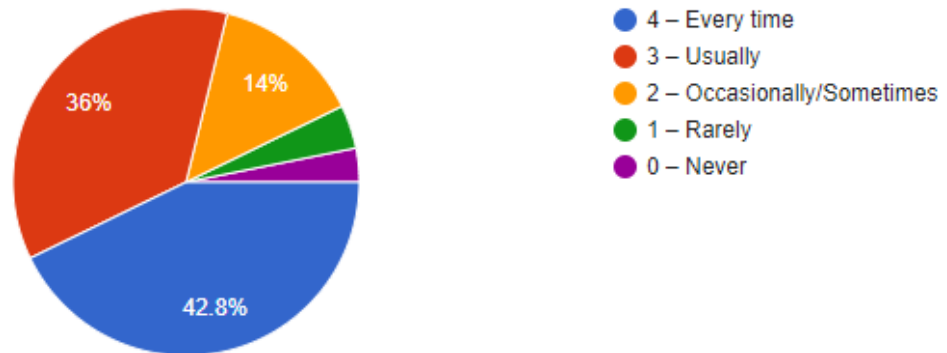


CHART-14 : Pie chart showing the perception of students that teachers are able to identify the weakness of the student and help them to overcome from it

15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.

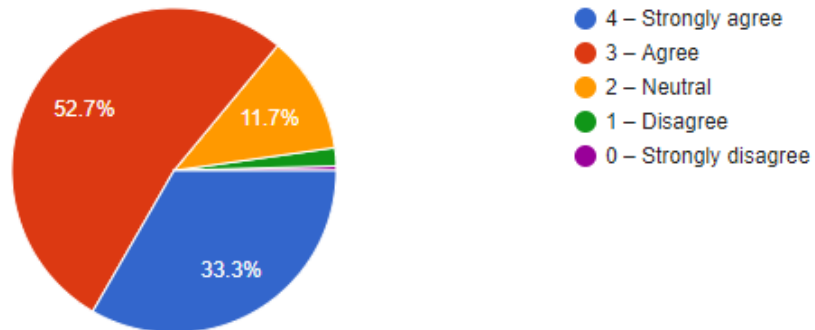


CHART-15 : Pie chart showing the perception of students that effort of the institution to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.

16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.

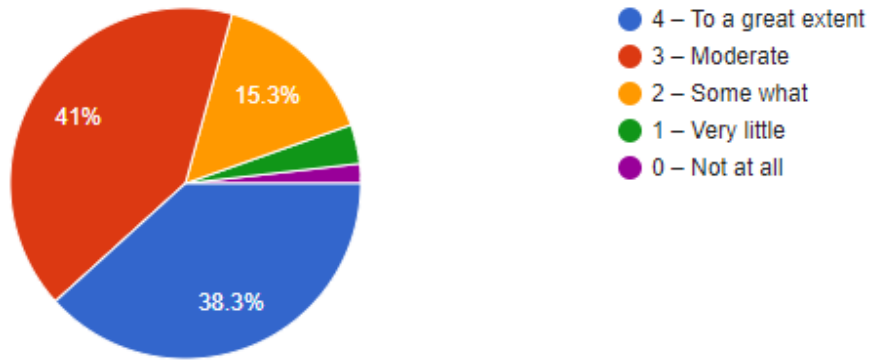

17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.

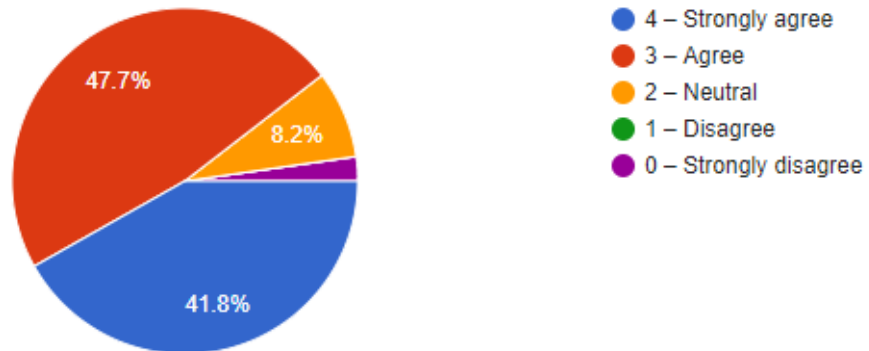


CHART-17 : Pie chart showing the perception of students on encouragement of teacher to students to participate in extracurricular activities

18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.

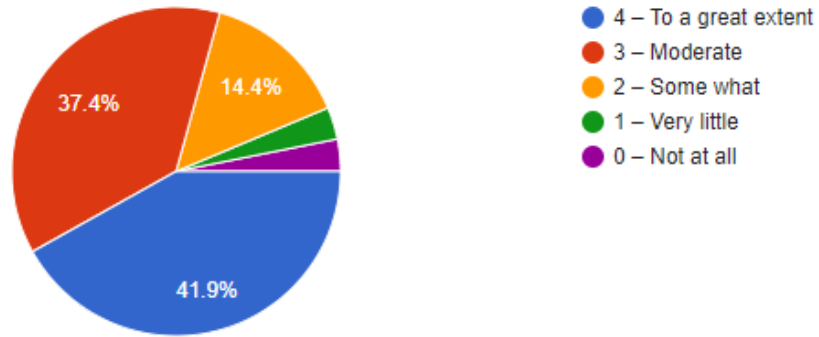

19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.

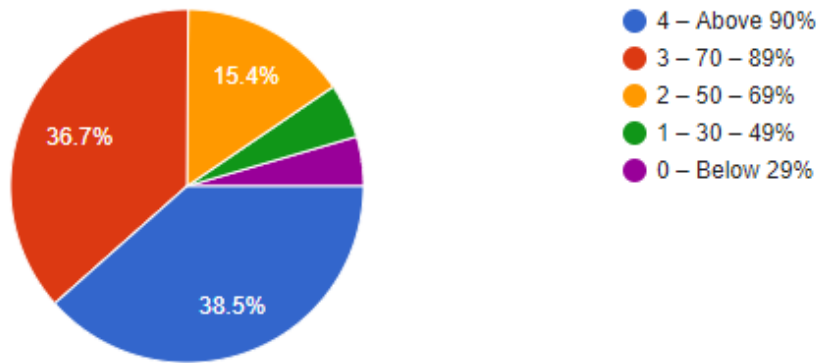


CHART-19 : Pie chart showing the perception of students on percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching

20. The overall quality of teaching-learning process in your institute is very good.

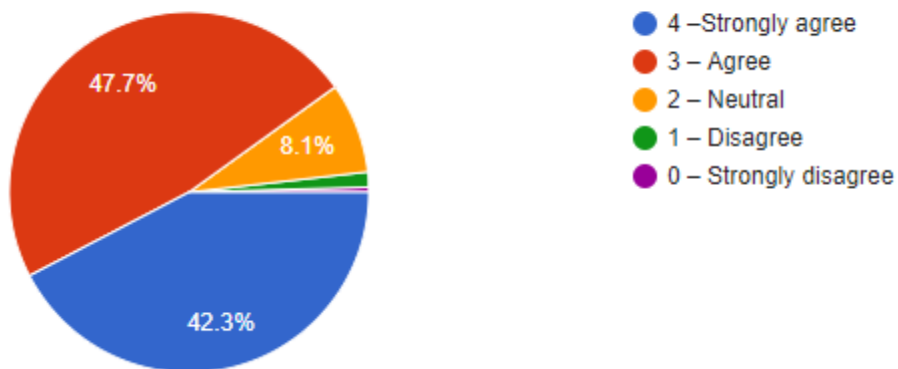


CHART-20 : Pie chart showing the perception of students on overall quality of teaching- learning process in the college is very good
