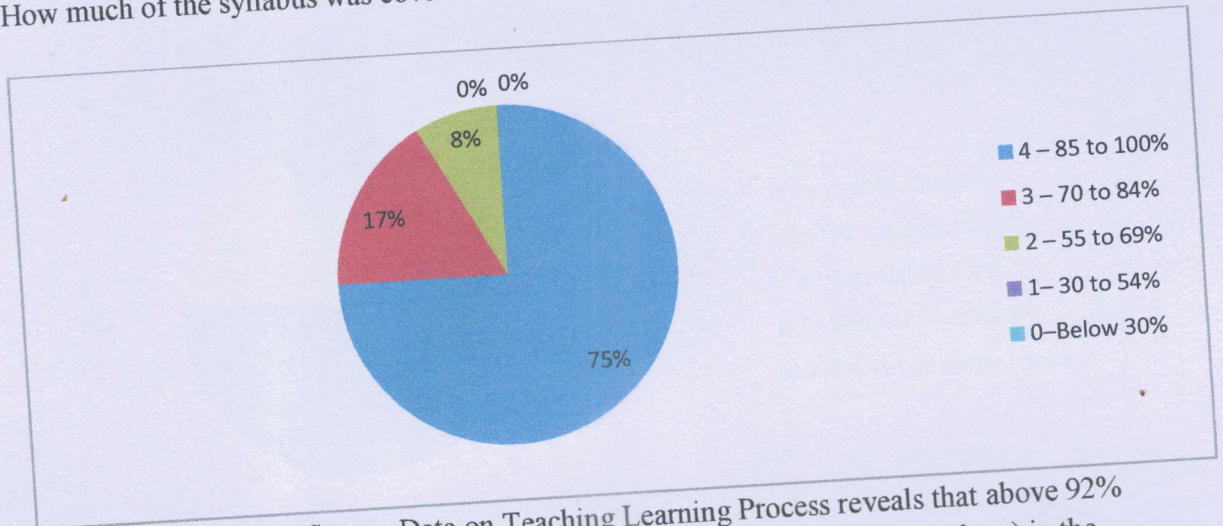

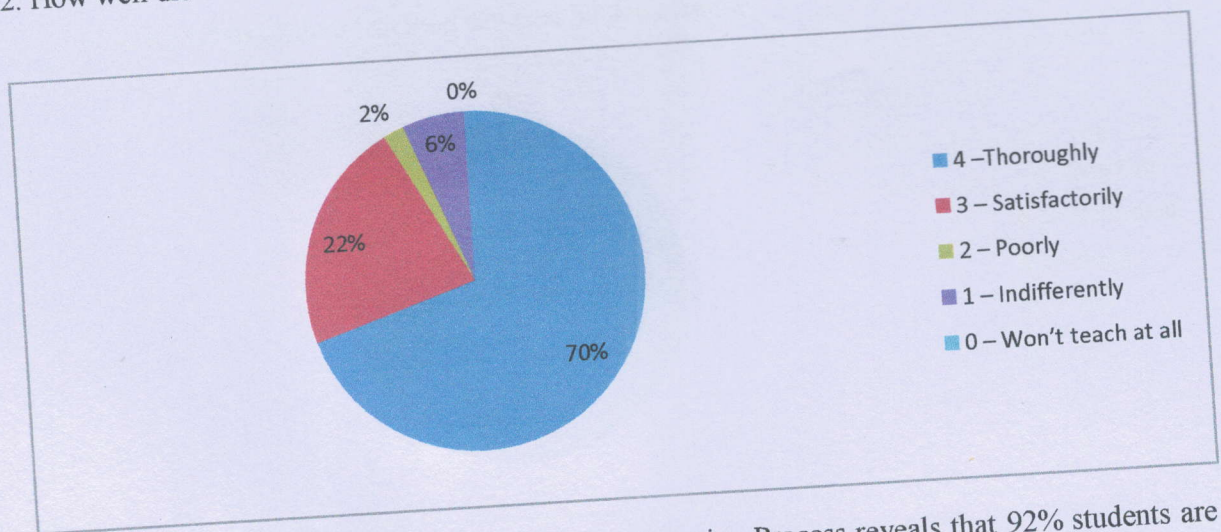

1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?



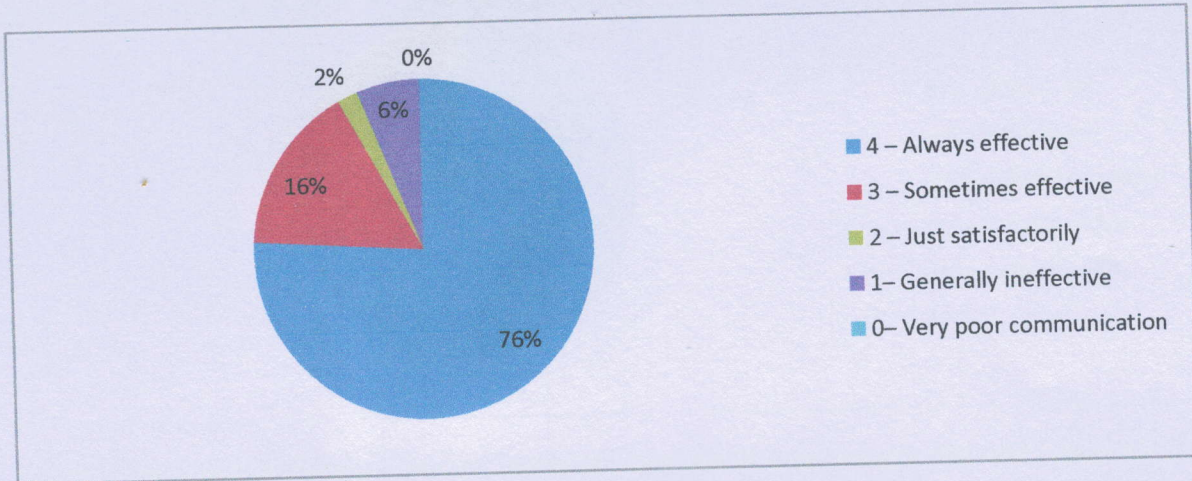

2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?



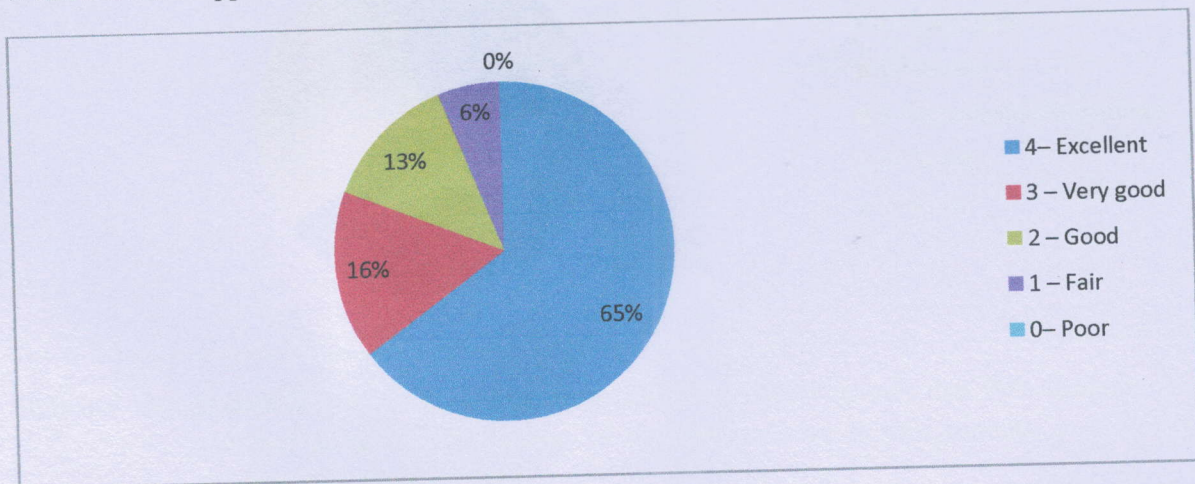
Students' Satisfaction Survey Data on Teaching Learning Process reveals that 92% students are satisfied about preparedness of teachers of the various departments of the college for their classes.

3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?



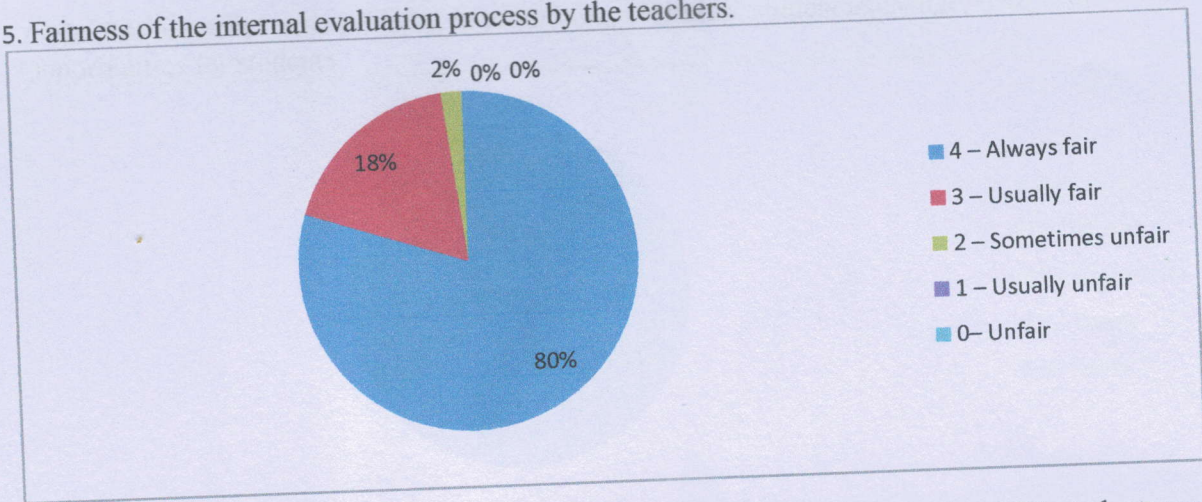

4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as



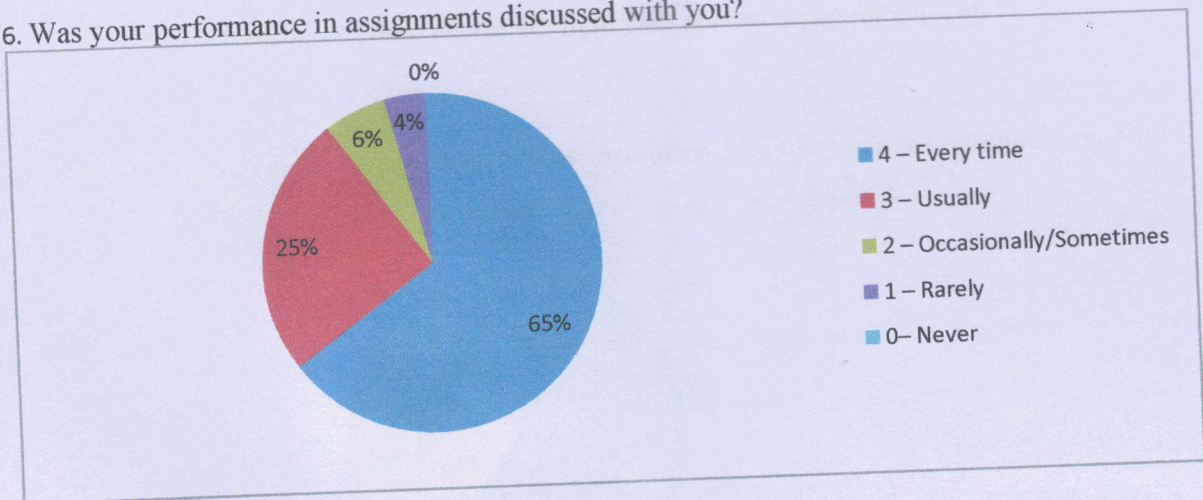
Students' Satisfaction Survey Data on Teaching Learning Process reveals that more than 81% students are very much satisfied about the teachers of the various departments of the college.

5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.



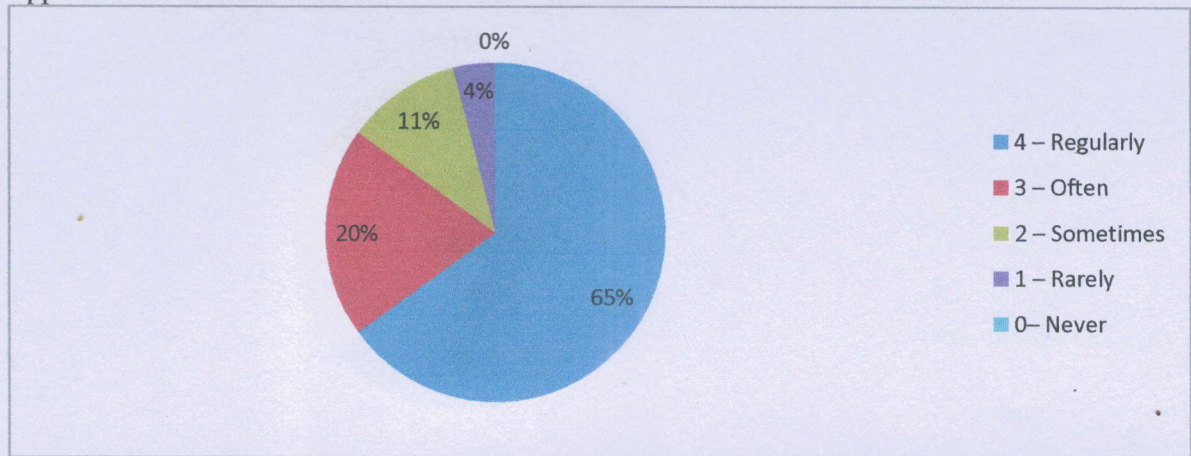
Students' Satisfaction Survey Data on Teaching Learning Process reveals that 98% students are satisfied about internal evaluation of the college.

6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?



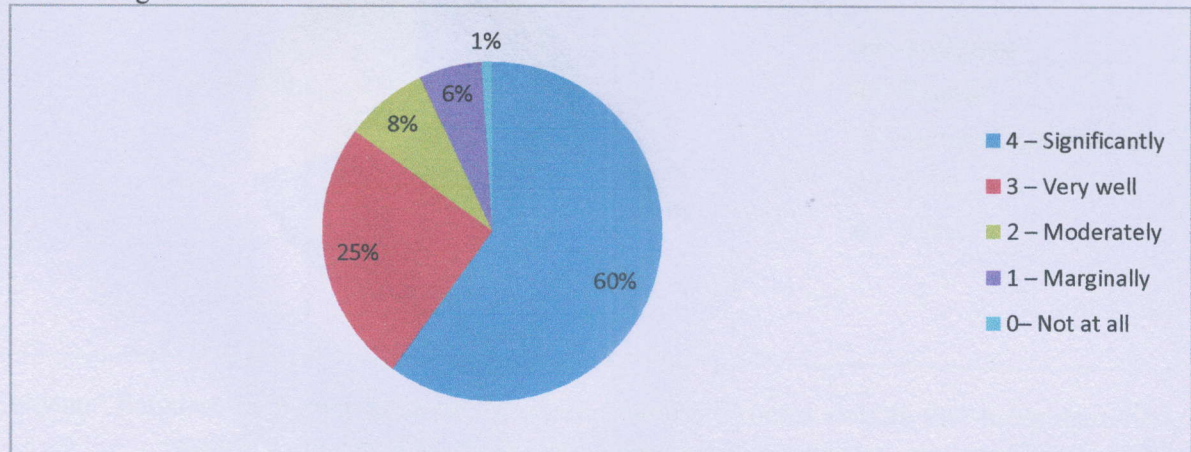

7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit Opportunities for students.



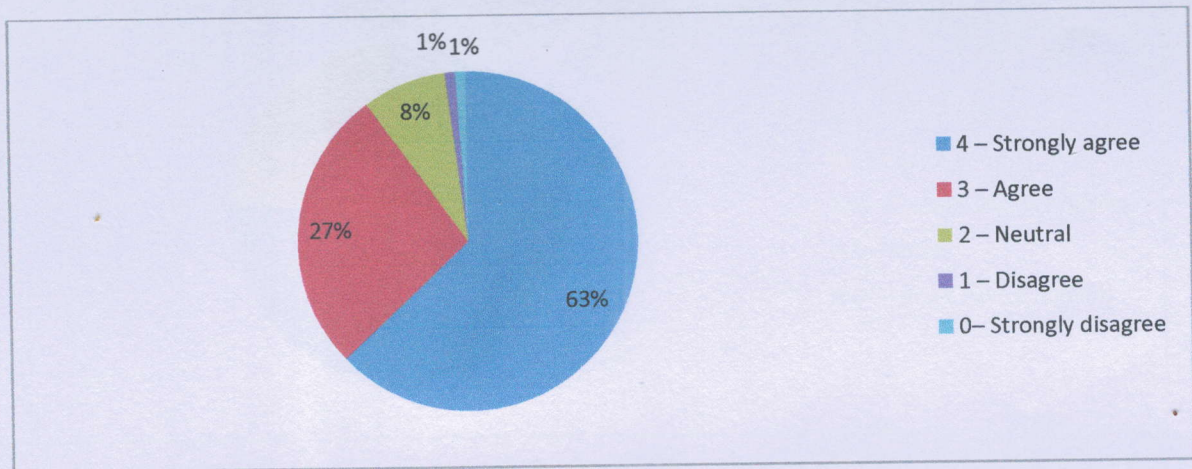

8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.



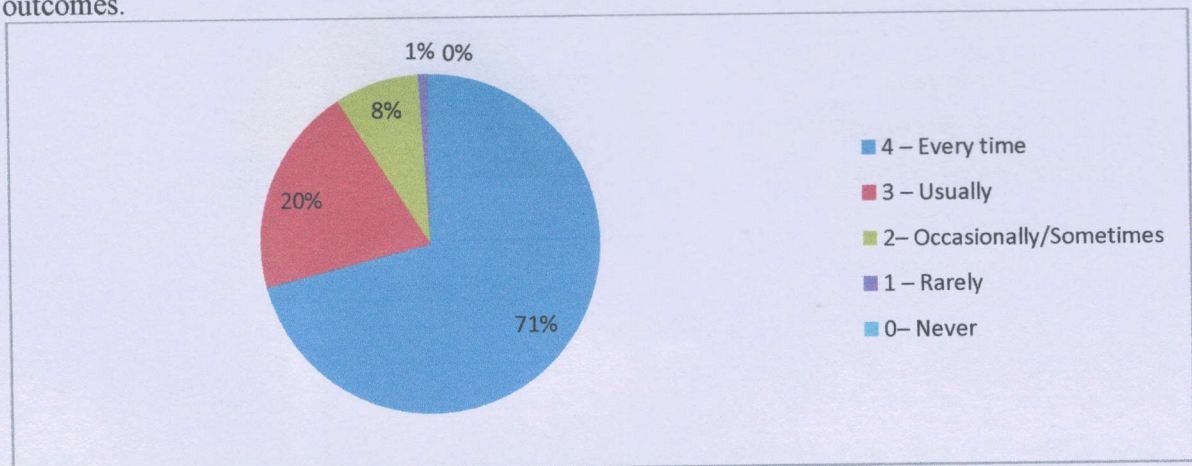

9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.



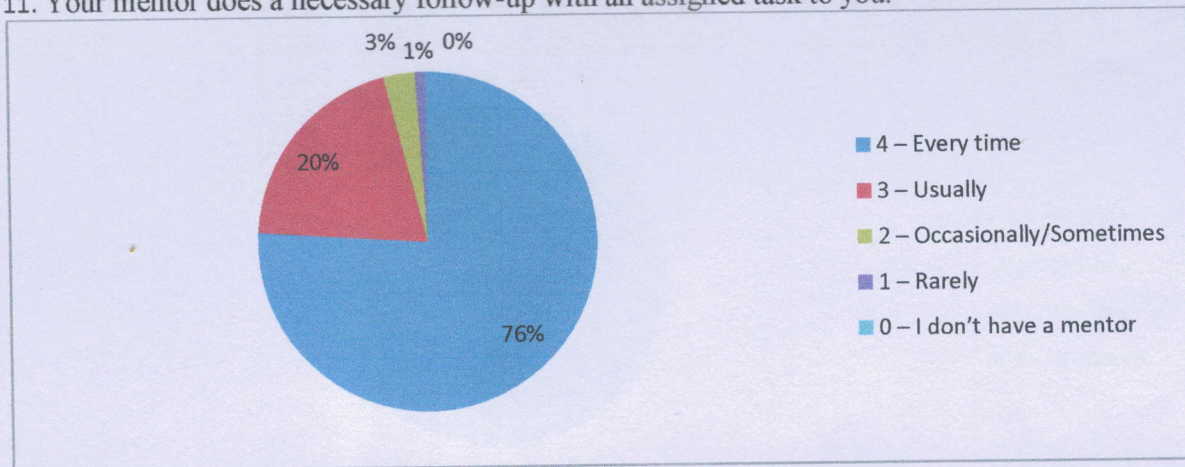

10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.



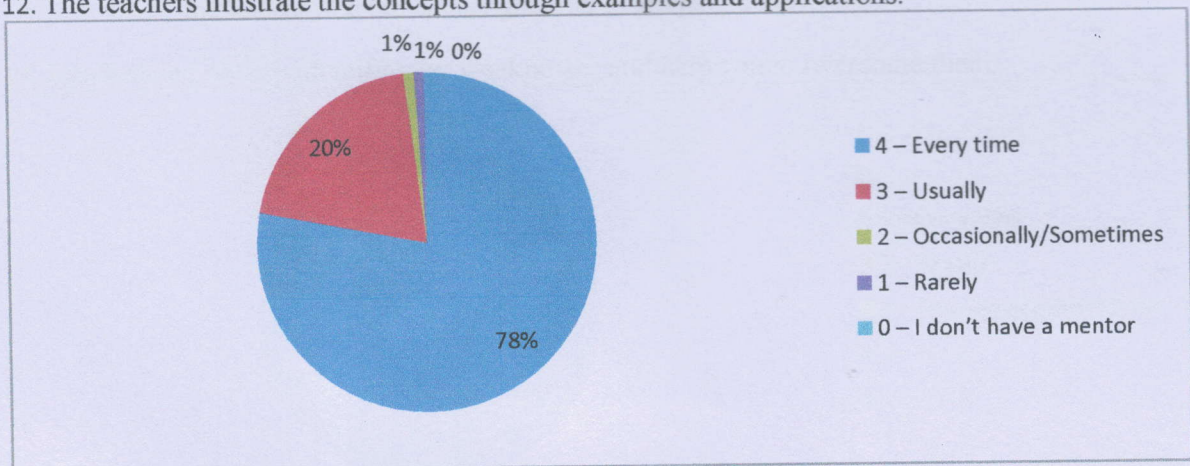

11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.



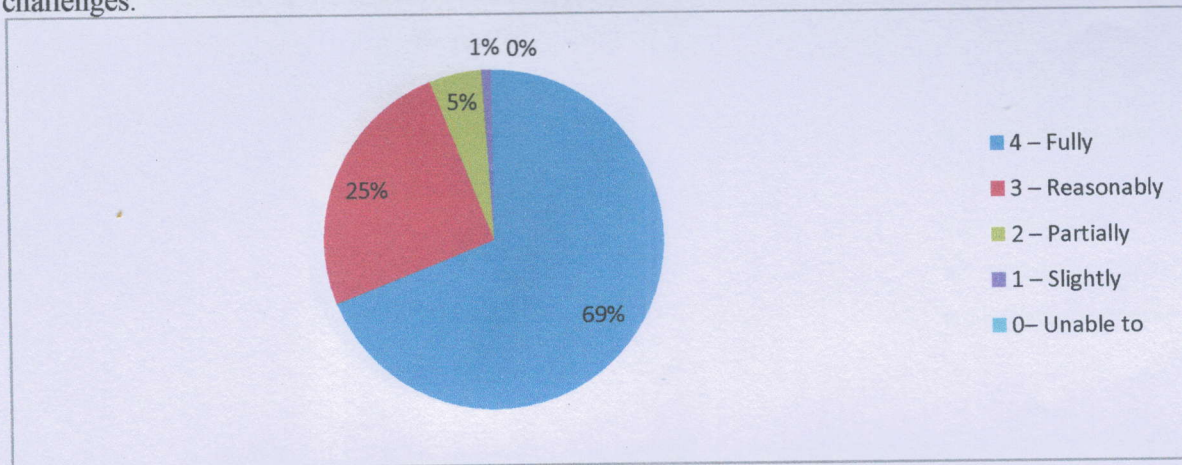

12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.



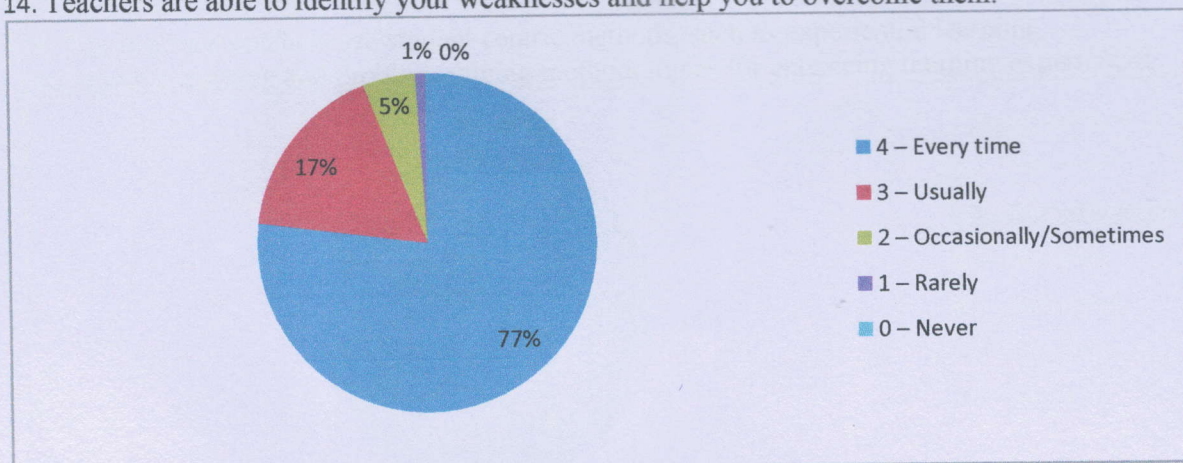
Students' Satisfaction Survey Data on Teaching Learning Process reveals that 98% students of the college perceived that teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications every time.

13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.



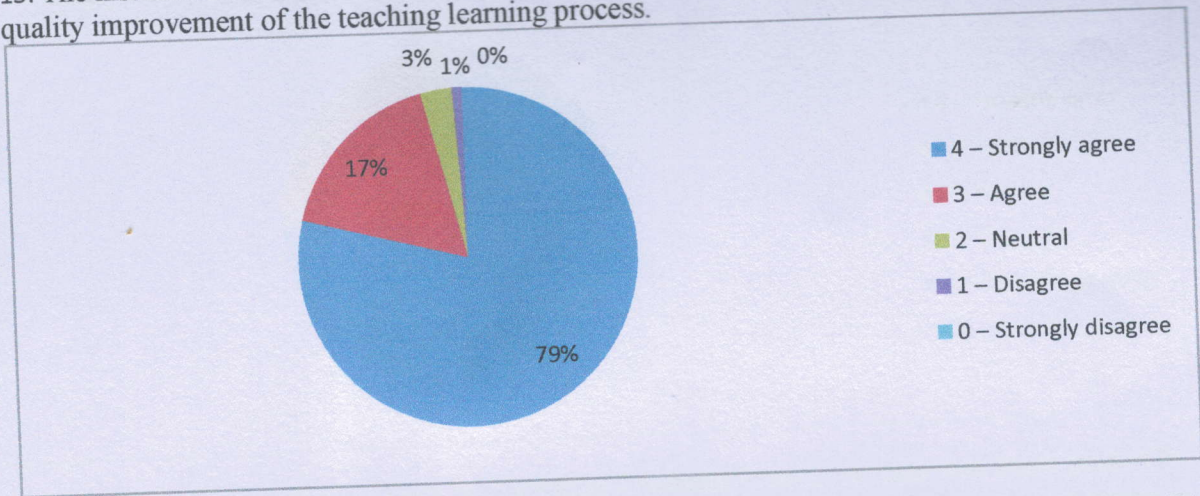

14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.



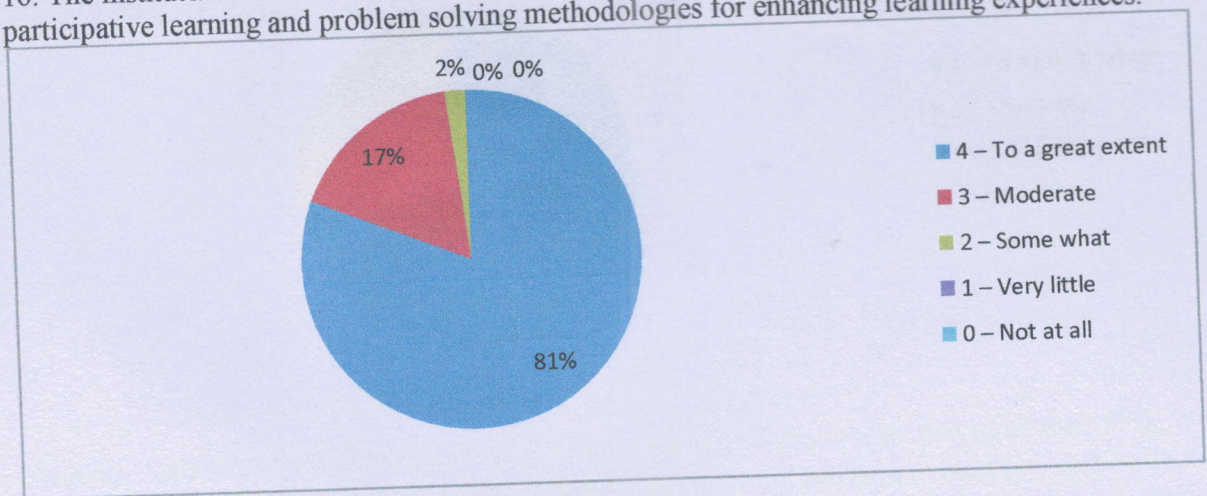

15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.



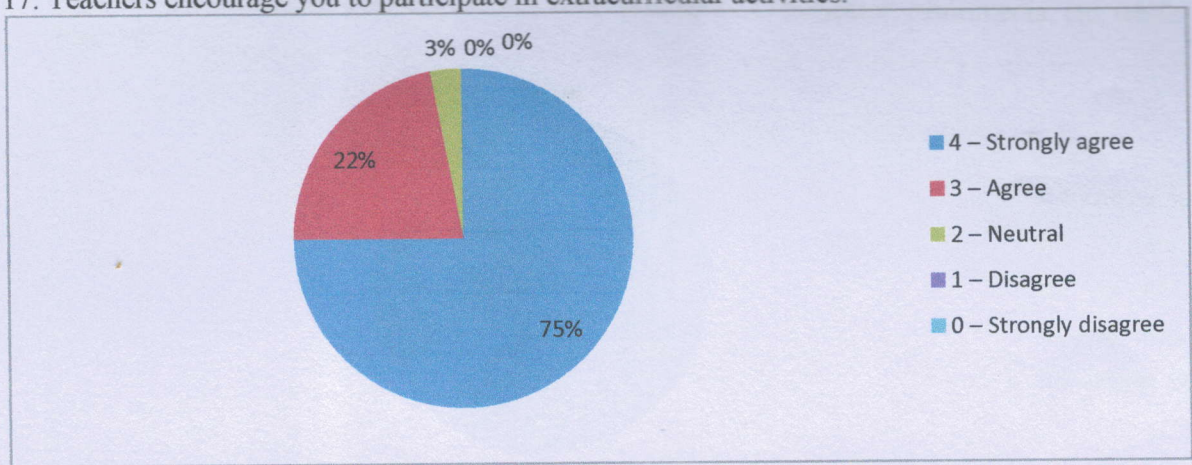

16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.



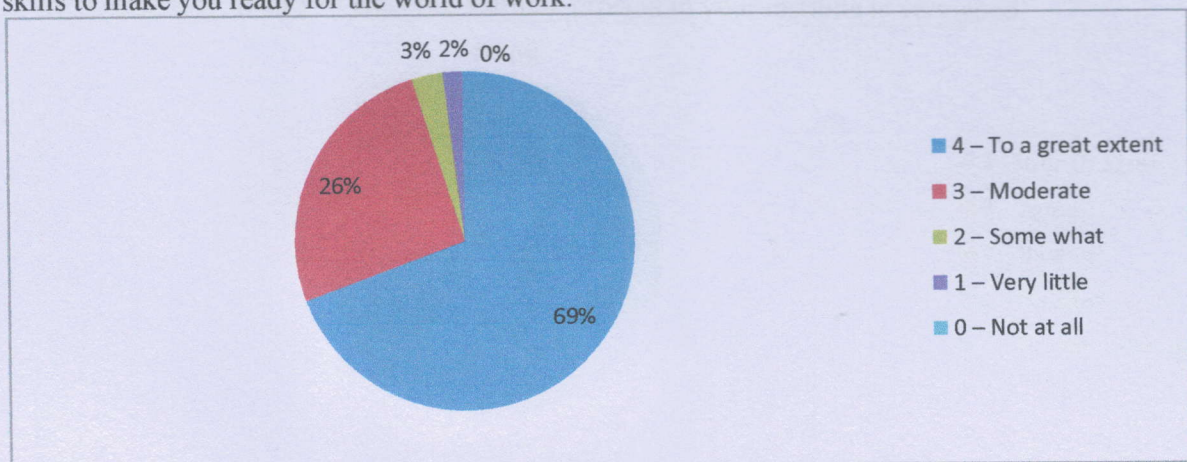

17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.



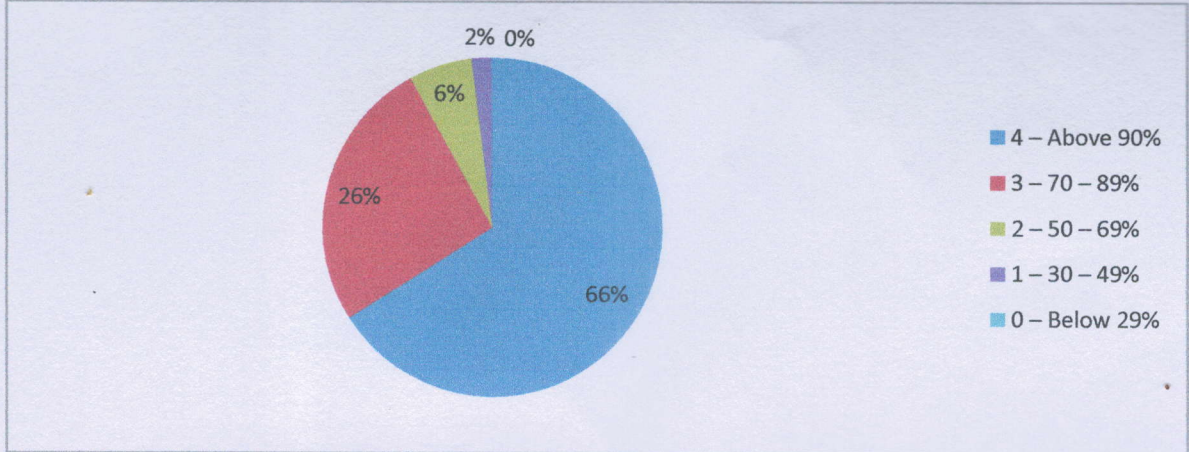

18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.



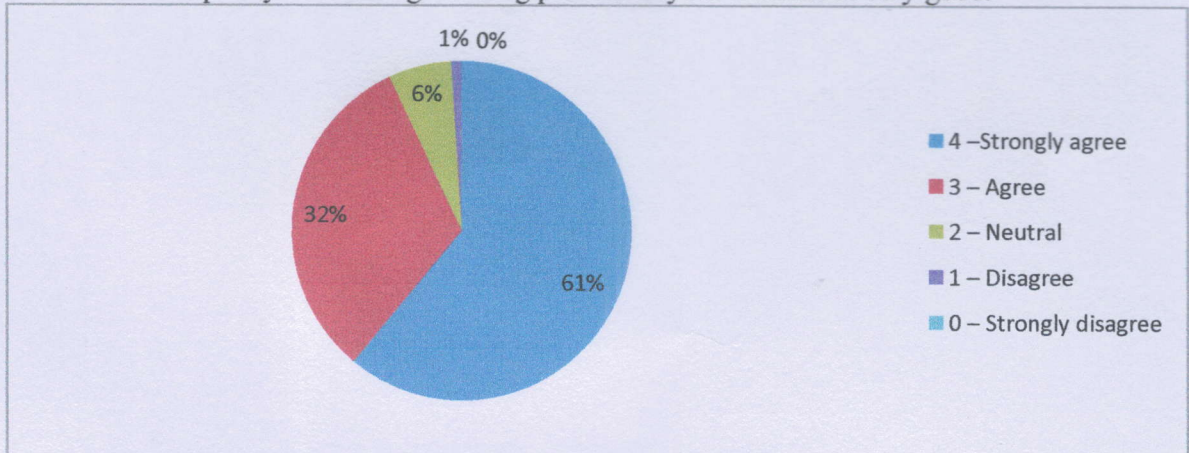
